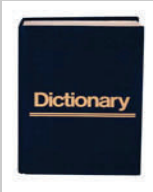

James F. Bassham was appointed as Director of TEMA by Governor Phil Bredesen in August of 2003. He previously served in state government as the Assistant Adjutant General of the Tennessee Air National Guard with the rank of Major General and then as Budget Officer for the Military Department of Tennessee. Since his appointment as Director, TEMA has attained conditional national accreditation in the Emergency Management Accreditation Program (only 16 states are fully or conditionally accredited), and Tennessee has been nationally recognized by the Federal Emergency Management Agency as one of only 10 states capable of implementing its plans in a catastrophic emergency.



He was commander of the National Guard Air Base in Memphis from 1993 to 1995 after having served as deputy or vice commander and commander of a series of units in Memphis over a period of 11 years. After almost 40 years of service, he retired in 2002 from the military with the Legion of Merit and a host of other medals and recognitions.

Jim was born and raised in Arkansas and received a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and Accounting from the University of Arkansas. He is fully National Incident Management System (NIMS) qualified, having completed the Advanced Incident Command System Course and the General Staff Complex Incidents Course.

He and his wife Judy live in Franklin, Tennessee. He has 2 daughters and 3 grandchildren.
